ACCE is accepting proposals from Healthcare Technology Management/Clinical Engineering Firms through October 29, 2021

The American College of Clinical Engineering (ACCE) with support from its Board, Healthcare Technology Certification Commission (HTCC) and United States and Canadian Board of Examiners is asking healthcare technology management/clinical engineering firms to submit proposals for the following services. The list below is a shorter version of the details outlined in the Request for Proposal (RFP):

1. Review, analyze, provide feedback, and provide recommendations on the current practices and protocols of the Certified Clinical Engineer (CCE) examination.
2. Review the eligibility criteria for the Board of Examiners (BoE) and the diversity in the current BoE. Provide feedback on potential BoE candidates.
3. Review the CCE exam format (written and oral) and participation rates to provide feedback on an exam format to ensure it is flexible and meets the needs of the industry in its current state.
4. Review the current format of the CCE oral exam and provide a feasibility analysis for a modified format.
5. Review the applicant eligibility criteria for the CCE exam, provide feedback, and recommend revisions.
